Presentation by Prof. em. Dr. Susanne Weigelin-Schwiedrzik, Univ. Wien

The author combines profound knowledge of China with a keen-eyed analysis of Beijing's stance in the Russian war against Ukraine and the strategic triangle in the - not just bipolar - Cold War. Today, as the world is reordering itself, Europe can and must take an active role vis-à-vis China, she argues. Her new book fills an important gap in identifying the interests of the People's Republic and the perspectives of Europe.

Prof. Weigelin-Schwiedrzik studied Sinology, Political Science, Japanese Studies and Chinese Language in Bonn, Beijing and Bochum. From 1989 to 2002 she was Professor of Modern Sinology in Heidelberg, and from 2002 to 2020 she was Professor of Sinology at the University of Vienna. As an expert on international relations involving China, she is a much sought-after contact for the media.
